### **Assessing Official Comments:**

QUALITY: The contractor and its staff deliver a high quality facility management and maintenance program that meets or exceeds the government's expectations. The facility is operated and maintained in a manner that it is within acceptable temperature limits, minimizes system downtime, and is robust. There were four facility emergencies this year, asbestos release, electrical utility service interruptions, and a flood, and in all four instances the contractor staff were fully engaged at all hours of the night and day and on the weekends to address and respond to the emergencies, to minimize the impact to the mission, and to return to normal operations in the shortest time possible.

SCHEDULE: The contractor meets the government's requirement for facility management and building maintenance. There was a high volume of simultaneous facilities projects underway, the contractor effectively oversaw these through to successful completion, and the contractor usually met schedule requirements.

COST CONTROL: The contractor fulfilled its responsibilities on budget. This was a firm-fixed price action.

MANAGEMENT: Because of the complexity of the environment and the amount of change underway at any give time, there is a high degree of management that is necessary to effectively fulfill the contract requirements and the contractor staff did a effective job of this.

REGULATORY COMPLIANCE: The boilers and chillers require annual inspections by the State of New Jersey Boiler and Pressure Vessel Office and the contractor coordinated the scheduling of the State Inspector and the boiler service contractor in order to achieve this requirement without system downtime and with no detrimental impact on the facility. The contractor oversaw/enforced/facilitated township and landlord inspections of various facilities work being performed by others.

ADDITIONAL/OTHER: The contractor staff possess the requisite skills and competencies for effective contract performance. Perhaps as important, the contractor staff have the internal drive and motivation to perform at an exceptional level and have demonstrated time and again their dedication to the government's mission.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Given what I know today about the contractor's ability to perform in accordance with this contract or order's most significant requirements, I would recommend them for similar requirements in the future.
