To Whom It May Concern:

Leisure Construction completed a Parapet Wall Replacement project for Department of Children and Family at Florida State Hospital in Chattahoochee Florida in 2014. The work consisted of removing 5' high x 50' long deteriorating brick veneer and partial brick removal and clean-up on west wall, removal of continuous 5"x5"x50' steel lintel east and west side. New construction at each area being approximately 5' high x 50' long will have 4" wide x 20 ga. "C" galvanized steel studs bolted to an existing continuous concrete beam, attach steel wall panels to produce a 5'x50'-0" fascia parapet. There was approximately 100' of bent metal coping, drip edge trim and caulking.

The team they provided worked great, and finished without any complaints from the tenants or staff. Leisure Construction completed the project on time and within the tight project budget that we had to work with.

We would not hesitate for a second in awarding them another project.
