When the owners needed to replace the building's old aluminum windows, they sought to do so on a budget without hindering structural performance. However, the owners assumed that they would need to replace the old aluminum windows with new aluminum windows.



An Ideal Fit

The owners replaced the old aluminum windows with 400 single hung windows from the 143 Series in a clay color.
