I understand you not being able to make it to the job site. We already need 26 hours in a day just to get the things completed that were due yesterday.

The crew did a good job and represented USUS in a professional manner. They were very patient with the plant, as they had to play "musical" pumps in order to keep 2 pumps running at all times, and take one off line to allow us to conduct the inspections. There was, as reflected in the logs, some down time while the plant worked thru the clearances. Corey was very attentive to overtime thresholds for the crew, and communicated this to me, and the plant, on numerous occasions during some of these periods of down time. James did a very good job on the inspections and was more than willing to conduct repeat inspections of specific areas for us when asked. I think Jesus took the opportunity that Corey provided to him to learn how to operate a rock drill and get some practical experience using it in a real work setting. He showed patience and a willingness to listen and learn as he worked while having to handle small parts, use of the rock drill, and overcome mid water column challenges.
