The contractor named above is herewith authorized to conduct asbestos abatement in the State of Oregon subject to the terms and conditions of Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 340 Division 248, including the conditions listed below.

1. The contractor must ensure that each worker performs asbestos abatement work in compliance with OAR 340-248-0010 through 340-248-0290 and other applicable state and federal asbestos abatement regulations.

2. Only those persons who have been properly trained and certified as workers or supervisors for asbestos abatement are permitted to engage in any asbestos abatement project conducted by the contractor.
3. A certified supervisor for Asbestos Abatement must be present at all times during full-scale asbestos abatement conducted by the contractor.
4. Notice of intent to begin an asbestos abatement project must be submitted to DEQ at least 10 days in advance of the start of each friable asbestos abatement project and at least 5 days before starting each non-friable asbestos abatement project the contractor engages in, subject to the provisions of OAR 340-248-0260. Each notification must be complete and accurate upon submittal or the notification shall be returned for corrections. Notifications and amendments must be submitted on current DEQ-approved forms. Forms and other information may be found at www.deq.state.or.us under "Air Quality/asbestos".
5. The contractor must allow DEQ representatives access to each project site and all pertinent records at all reasonable times for the purposes of making inspections, collecting samples, obtaining data, reviewing and copying asbestos abatement project records, inspecting abatement worker certification cards, and otherwise conducting all necessary functions related to this license.
6. Failure to comply with the conditions given above and/or fraudulent procurement of this license may result in enforcement action including license suspension or revocation.
7. Request for renewal of this license shall be made on DEQ-approved forms at least 60 days prior to the license expiration date.
