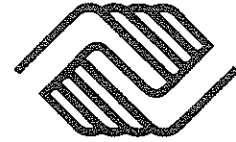

This letter of recommendation from The Boys & Girls Club of Geneva Inc. is written to recognize the stellar work the Chrisantha Construction performed in planning, implementing, and following up on the construction of the Geneva Community Center in Geneva NY. This \$5,200,000 was completed on time and on budget chiefly due to Chrisantha's skill and experience, and on behalf of our entire organization I would like to take this opportunity to publically recognize your company, and say thank you for a job well done.

In working with Chrisantha I would point to 4 key areas that stood out in the effort to build a Community Center for our region. They are:

- **Cost Effectiveness**
- **Flexibility**
- **Quality**
- **Follow up**

In each of the areas above, Chrisantha excelled in bringing the Community Center on line in September of 2009. The overall **cost** of construction was made manageable by timely suggestions such as pre buying the steel before the costs rose, using tile instead of carpet in some areas, maximizing overhead storage etc. The **flexibility** that Chrisantha brought to the table allowed for signs to be hung on time, room dimensions to change as needed, trees on the 14 acre construction site to be saved and lockers to be added in theatre dressing rooms. The **quality** of both the materials and workmanship were top notch from the maple wood for the gym floor, to exterior lighting and drywall, all of the materials that went into the Community Center were top grade. Finally and to me one of the most important parts of working with a project of this size is the **follow up** on the project that Chrisantha provided, if some small thing was not right (a door alignment or a piece of hardware needed adjustment) they were right there to make sure that the facility was working properly.

I have only scratched the surface in this letter and in my 25 years in working with not for profit facilities I have never had a better experience with a company.
