Law Enforcement Commendation Award Michael Dudek

On May 27, 2010, Trooper Quaron Crenshaw #7181 was detailed to investigate a motor vehicle accident on I-195 WB in Hamilton Township, Mercer County, New Jersey. Upon arrival, Tpr. Crenshaw observed a vehicle resting against the guardrail with the victim unresponsive in the driver's seat. During this time two civilians, Mr. Greg Walters, a certified EMT, and Mr. Michael Dudek, a certified CPR instructor, stopped to render aid.


At the scene the guide rail was obstructing access to the victim. Together the three men pushed the vehicle off the guardrail to gain access to the victim. At this point they performed an assessment and determined she was not breathing and did not have a pulse. Tpr. Crenshaw and Mr. Walters began two-person CPR. Mr. Walters was joined by Mr. Dudek as Tpr. Crenshaw went to retrieve the AED. Once he returned a shock was administered without success. The AED was administered three times in conjunction with CPR.

After approximately five minutes they obtained a slight pulse. Capital Health Paramedics arrived on scene and continued lifesaving measures. Once the victim was stabilized she was airlifted to the University of Pennsylvania for advanced treatment. She was released eight days later.

Mr Dudek, and Mr Walters' actions during this lifesaving incident have brought great pride and distinction to themselves and their families.
