Description: LAC - VARIOUS UNINCORPORATED AREAS (PCA - LDROBOX)

Scope of Work
PURPOSE : To place and remove drop box debris containers at various locations within the unincorporated areas described below. No drop box debris container shall remain at any one (1) location for more than seven (7) consecutive days.

A Drop Box Debris Container is any container of one cubic yard in size or greater that is used for the collection and temporary holding of construction, demolition and lot clearing debris and waste. The drop box container must not be used for the collection or storage of hazardous materials or hazardous waste. The Drop Box Debris Containers do not include Solid-Waste Collection Containers as described in the Los Angeles County Utilities Code in Title 20, Division 4, Chapter 20.72.

The Permittee shall not use the public road right of way for its drop box debris container storage business operations.

THIS PERMIT IS VALID UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2016.

THE PERMITTEE SHALL APPLY FOR THE ANNUAL DROP-BOX DEBRIS CONTAINER PERMIT RENEWAL AT LEAST THREE (3) WEEKS PRIOR TO DECEMBER 31st.

BEFORE PERMITTEE PLACES ANY DROP BOX DEBRIS CONTAINER WITHIN THE COUNTY'S PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT OF WAY, THE CUSTOMER REQUESTING THE DROP BOX DEBRIS CONTAINER MUST OBTAIN AN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FROM THE PERMIT OFFICE NEAREST TO WHERE THE DROP BOX DEBRIS CONTAINER WILL BE PLACED. NO DROP BOX DEBRIS CONTAINER SHALL BE PLACED IN THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT OF WAY WITHOUT A PERMIT ISSUED TO THE CUSTOMER. THE PERMIT OFFICES ARE LISTED BELOW:
