### ***Solid Waste/Contractor Hauling Permit For Year 2016-2017***

Your application/renewal for a Private Waste Hauler Permit has been approved by the City of Los Angeles. Your permit number for fiscal year 2016-2017 is **PER-09-105**. Please reference this number in any correspondence to the City related to the private waste hauler permit program. We have enclosed 13 decal(s), the same amount as the number of vehicles that was reported in your permit application/renewal. If you need more decals for new or replacement vehicles, you may request additional decals in writing. Please be advised that this permit is good until June 30, 2017.

All haulers and contractors that collect, transport, and/or dispose more than 1,000 tons of solid waste per year are required to pay the AB939 Compliance Fee equivalent to 10% of gross receipts. Payments are due to our office within thirty days after the end of each calendar quarter. Quarterly payment forms must accompany the quarterly fee payments. Permitted haulers that take materials to City-certified processors may be eligible for rebates. When submitting your quarterly payments, please note that the definition of gross receipts is in accordance with Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 21.00a. In addition, when calculating gross receipts the passed on fee should not be included. For example, if a customer's bill was \$100 and is now charged \$100 plus the \$10 fee (\$110 total), the gross receipts is \$100, not \$110. ### **ZERO WASTE LA FRANCHISE SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION**

The City adopted the "Zero Waste LA" Ordinance in 2014, which authorized the City to issue contracts for the collection of solid waste from commercial establishments. The City continues to progress in the implementation of that ordinance and will provide permitted waste haulers with additional information at a later date. ### **Additional important information:**

- Mixed C&D Waste Collection in the City - Reminder that per Ordinance 181519, as of January 1, 2011, all mixed C&D waste generated within the City can only be delivered to City-Certified C&D waste processors; C&D waste cannot be taken to landfills or transfer stations. You must obtain rejection slips from at least two City-Certified C&D waste processors before you can utilize a non-City certified facility, and retain copies of those rejection slips in your records, where they must be available for inspection.
