

Grand Prairie Police arrested several guys attempting to steal metal spools of wire in an outdoor yard. Officer Jerry Bryant wrote, "Officers were on scene in about 2 minutes and had the first suspect in custody in about 20 minutes from receiving the initial call. The second suspect was found about 10 minutes after that. A total of 7 officers were dispatched which also included K9, additionally, Air One Helicopter was in route, but we had already located the suspects prior to their arrival. The use of the video alarm was a key aspect in this case. Knowing the suspects were probably still on scene, officers flooded the area."

With my wireless verified video alarm system, I have helped the police to make 55 apprehensions in the last 5 years. The video clips show the intruder, face down, with police handcuffing him. The video system sends a ten second video-clip to the monitoring station, where someone is watching and can dispatch the police. The video clip is sent in real time over the cellular network. Here's proof that the system works not only to detect, but to stop the crime in progress.
