To Whom It May Concern:

Mr. Tony Flores asked me to write this letter on his behalf as a reference as to his ability as a contractor. Mr. Flores and I met in the late 1960's and have had a working relationship ever since. I have the utmost respect and confidence in him as an architect and have relied on his advise numerous times when solving problems on some of my various construction projects.

I have asked Mr. Flores to assist me in completing various types of construction projects, several times, when I would find that I was not going to have the time to spend on the job sites. One such project was a two story addition across the rear of a house in West University, Houston, Texas. The cost of the project was approximately seventy thousand dollars (\$ 70,000.00). Mr. Flores handled all of the sub bidding as well as the required site supervision. Another project as a total remodel of a house in Memorial. On that project, we added about 50% to the air conditioned floor space, converted a two car garage into a three car garage with quarters above it, and totally revised the pool deck and back yard landscaping. The total cost of the rework was around one hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$ 180,000.00). I was so pleased with that particular project that I sold the house that I was living in and moved into the Memorial project - and live there today.

Mr. Flores has also helped be on several commercial projects. Again, he was involved in the estimating as well as the supervision of these projects - thru completion. One such project was a 17,000 sq. ft. shopping center on Westheimer Rd., Houston, Texas.

On each of the projects that Mr. Flores was involved with, I was extremely satisfied with his attention to details as well as his ability to work with the subcontractors and get the projects completed on time and within budget.
