This letter is to inform you that your application to operate a trade waste business filed with the New York City Business Integrity Commission ("Commission") has been approved, subject to your agreement to the conditions set forth in the Commission's Order granting your registration application. You must make an appointment to pick up your Registration and trade waste conveyance license plates by August 15, 2017. To make your appointment, visit www.nyc.gov/bic and click on the "Schedule an Appointment" link.

A Registration will be issued only if the principal is present to complete the registration process.

You <u>must bring this letter</u> as well all the items listed below in order to pick up your registration and trade waste conveyance license plates:

- 1. A blank check to pay for your truck(s) fee (trade waste conveyance license plates).
- 2. A photo identification issued by city, state, or federal government.
- 3. One (1) copy of DMV Vehicle Registration for each vehicle used to collect, transport or dispose of waste. Must be current and in the business name.
- 4. One (1) copy of the Insurance Card for each vehicle used to collect, transport or dispose of waste. Must be current and in the business name.
- 5. One (1) copy of Certificate of Automobile Liability Insurance with limits of no less than \$100,000 for personal injury to any one person, \$300,000 for personal injury to 2 or more persons, and \$25,000 for damage to property for all vehicles. Must be current and in the business name. The Business Integrity Commission must be listed as the Certificate Holder.
- 6. One (1) copy of Proof of Workers' Compensation Insurance coverage in the company's name for your employees naming the New York City Business Integrity Commission as the certificate holder or proof of exemption from Workers' Compensation insurance coverage.

Your registration will not be issued if you fail to bring all the above listed documents. If you have any questions please call (212) 437-0555 or email licensing@bic.nyc.gov.

All fees must be paid in full at the time of registration.
