DOMINOS GETS A MAKEOVER

EPOXY FLOOR COATING MAKES A GREAT CHOICE

Flooring systems in restaurants demand special attention. When you are working with concrete flooring and considering using a coating, the coatings must be exceptionally durable, easy to clean, safe and skid-resistant. When it came time for the Domino's pizza restaurant on Lincoln Way West in Chambersburg to choose which floor solution to go with, an epoxy coating from Sherwin Williams was the choice. ReflecCRETE, a commercial concrete floor polishing and refinishing contractor was chosen to complete this project. With any project that uses an existing floor slab, it is imperative to make sure that the floor slab is properly prepped before the application of the epoxy.

This required abrading the floor with a concrete floor grinder to obtain a proper surface profile. The concrete floor also had moisture vapor issues and a fast curing moisture mitigation primer was used as a base coat to prevent moisture from seeping up through the surface and lifting off the epoxy coating. The epoxy coating was self-leveling which is useful on concrete floor slabs that may have dips and uneven surfaces. The Domino's

floor specification calls for self-leveling epoxy with paint chips light broadcast into the epoxy. A final coating of 2 two component clear urethane was used to seal in the paint chips and give the epoxy floor a nice sheen.
