he story of Garfield Middle School began over a century ago. The core of the existing school was constructed in 1894 and numerous additions were constructed in the intervening decades.

The architects at URS and construction managers at Regency Turner designed the new 170,000 square foot facility around the portion of the façade that was to remain as a permanent link to Lakewood's proud past.

The engineering and design of a temporary support system was left up to the successful bidder. Drawing on its experience in the field of tilt-up, concrete wall construction, C. T. Taylor's engineers designed an

There is a rich tradition of history in Lakewood and a dedicated group of citizens expressed a desire to preserve and protect a significant portion of the existing school. Although it had suffered the ravages of time, it was decided to retain and restore a major portion of the façade facing Detroit Avenue.

external skeleton to support the existing masonry walls while the guts of the old building were torn out and replaced with a new steel and precast concrete structure.

The state of the art artificial turf athletic field serves a dual purpose for the middle school and as a community recreational facility.
