Hi Roxanne,

I'm writing this to let you know that, after a few hard starts and one or two small hurdles, I am very satisfied with the results of the work performed by QSSI on the passive barrier project. The final product is a very professional installation and shows great attention to detail. The railings and boulders are very well positioned and, after slight modifications in alignment as suggested by the contractor during construction, have greater functionality and aesthetic appeal than the original layout.

I was often called to the project site to clear up any problems BEFORE they became difficult to undo, and any errors in production were quickly corrected.

This was a difficult project to accomplish for all involved because of circumstances that only revealed themselves during construction. QSSI worked well with us in resolving last minute design changes. They were flexible with us and with their subcontractor throughout the construction of this project that seemed to be in a state of continual redesign.

I also want to mention that Joe Brown (QSSI construction superintendent) stayed on top of all problems until they were resolved. He is easy to work with and knows how to "get things done".
