To Whom It May Concern:

In 2015, we took back a 25,000 square foot building that was designed as a Tier II data center. 18" raised floor, Liebert AC units, redundant power, two 2,500 KW stand-by generators and a 10,000 gallon diesel tank, 10 – 35 ton chilled Water CRAC Units, Overhead System - 80 Tons (Able to cool 16 KW per rack), two York cooling towers at 428 tons each, 25,000 make u water storage tank, chill water pumps @ 800 GPM, the list goes on and on.

Due to logistics, we decided to decommission the building and we selected Data Center Power Equipment to handle the job for us. We actually completed the decommissioning in two phases and Data Center Power Equipment helped us every step of the way as decommissioning a building with such intricate infrastructure is not our field of expertise. Their on-site workers were very professional, and they got the job done quickly with no issues. Anthony Beck was our main contact person and he was on-site throughout the projects making certain everything was properly disconnected and the building was clean when they finished.
