The removal of partitions, flooring, windows, etc., incidental to a renovation or remodeling project is NOT within this category To prequalify for Demolition, you must have a Demolition Contractor Certificate of Registration through the State of Connecticut Department of Administrative Services - Office of the State Fire Marshal.
LEAD ABATEMENT	The undertaking of lead abatement projects involving one or more of the following: scraping and/or chemical stripping of lead paint; encapsulation and covering of lead contaminated surfaces; or removal and replacement of windows, woodwork or other contaminated surfaces. To prequalify for Lead Abatement, you must have a Lead Contractor License through the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health.
GENERAL TRADES	The undertaking of general contracts for the construction and/or supervision of several sub-trades but not the construction of buildings as described in General Building Construction. The contract must include a variety of construction practices and supervision of a minimum of three sub- trades. The work of this category is intended for the interior finishes of a building.

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
