I worked closely with both Dennis and Brad Reeves during the construction of the Claremont University Consortium's Campus Administrative Center. The Reeves and their crew were great to work with—responsive, prompt and made every effort to understand design intent—and more importantly they did great work. The millwork scope for the project was extremely complicated including douglas fir posts for glass partition supports, stone counters with felt infill panels, bamboo plywood cabinetry, custom cedar clad cabinetry, a walnut conference table with CNC milled panels, CNC-perforated bamboo plywood wall panels, cedar and stainless steel clad partitions, cantilevered cedar clad banquettes, and more. Reeves was able to handle the complexity of all of this highly custom work and execute it flawlessly. They built everything to our drawings and whenever there was any question as to design intent they immediately reached out to us in order to reach a speedy resolution. Reeves' excellent work was essential to the project's success (it has been featured in the LA Times, Architectural Record and other publications in addition to winning multiple awards).
