Anthony Dragone Sr. of American Architectural Restoration has been working on all our exterior and interior issues. Work includes stones, bricks, deck coating, and EPDM roofing. For the past five years we have had serious water issues on our fifth floor that were so severe we had to close off the entire floor. American Architectural Restoration specifications were approved by the historical preservation society at West Point. He has successfully stopped every leak. In 2010, we had a state of emergency snow storm and one of our turrets was leaking severely. My manager called Anthony Dragone Sr. and told him how bad the problem was. His response was, "I'm on the way up with my men." He arrived in approximately two hours. Anthony Dragone and his men went on the roof and scaffold in the blizzard, wrapped the turret with plastic and stopped the water from causing severe damage. He had told me upon meeting him at West Point that if there were ever a problem I could call him any day or time and he will be there, and he has proven that many times.

I find that Anthony Dragone Sr. to be a man of his word, His experience, knowledge and follow up after the work is completed has impressed us. He will be working for the Thayer Hotel now and in the future. I recommend American Architectural Restoration with confidence.
