Project Description: During the final stages of an ongoing remediation at the referenced site, Sevenson discovered an “orphan” fuel oil underground storage tank (UST). Renova was initially contracted to provide support assistance for the removal of the UST. Renova was required to submit a Health and Safety Plan and Workplan for the required work. During the actual field work, Renova was responsible for cutting the UST with spark-proof equipment, safely entering the UST under Sevenson’s confined space entry permit, arranging for the removal and disposal of the contents, and sampling upon removal of the UST.

Follow-on work was issued to Renova due to the discharge confirmed from the UST. This work was comprised of conducting a remedial investigation to determine the bounds of the plume, providing oversight of remediation activities, transportation and disposal of the petroleum-impacted soil, confirmatory soil and groundwater sampling and analysis, and report preparation and submission.

Contractor Evaluation: Our expectations were met by Renova during all stages of project that they contributed to. The work was completed efficiently and cost-effectively.


Schedule: Renova completed their work according to the schedule that they issued. Changes to the schedule due to weather delays were conveyed in a timely manner.
