SECURITY GUARD SERVICES AND TRAINING

In the event that there are changes, you must notify the MTA, within 30 days, of any changes in your business' ownership, control and/or operations including address, telephone number, business services and capabilities. Failure to adhere to these requirements may result in the removal of your firm's DBE certification status. Your firm's next annual submission will be due on or before December 14, 2017.

Your firm will continue to be included in the NYSUCP Directory which is located at <https://nysucp.newnycontracts.com>. The directory will indicate the type of work your firm has been certified to perform.




