## Certificate of License License # 347

In accordance with the requirements of Chapter 826-a of the Laws of Westchester County, the Licensee shall notify the Westchester County Solid Waste Commission in a timely manner of any material changes, additions or modifications to the information provided by the Licensee to the Westchester County Solid Waste Commission, whether pursuant to its application for licensure or otherwise.

The Licensee shall at all times cooperate fully with the Westchester County Solid Waste Commission including providing the Commission with requested information in a timely and professional manner.

As a condition of this license, the Licensee shall comply, at its own expense, with all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and ordinances which may be applicable to the Licensee in connection with its performance of the activities for which it has been issued a license hereunder, and, in particular those antitrust or other laws relating to the restraint of trade.

The conditions imposed hereby, as outlined above, shall remain in full force and effect until such time as a new License Certificate is issued by the Westchester County Solid Waste Commission from which the references to such conditions have been deleted.

This license is issued by the County of Westchester solely in accordance with the stated purposes Chapter 826-a of the Laws of Westchester County, which are to reduce corruption in the solid waste hauling industry and to ensure accurate reporting of waste hauling activities in accordance with the Westchester County Solid Waste Management Plan, and is in no way intended to operate to ensure the safety or capacity of the vehicles, equipment, and/or employees operated and/or utilized by the Licensee in connection with the operation of this license. The Licensee hereby acknowledges and agrees that it shall hold harmless the County of Westchester for any and all claims for damage to property and/or persons which the Licensee may cause in connection with the operation of this license for the duration of the term of this license.

Nothing herein shall be construed to limit or impair the authority of the Westchester County Solid Waste Commission to revoke or suspend this license in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 826-a of the Laws of Westchester County.

Part "B" of this License Certificate shall be posted and conspicuously displayed in the principal office or location of the Licensee's Westchester County operations in accordance with Section 826-a.303(5) of the Laws of Westchester County. Copies of Part "B" of this License Certificate shall be conspicuously displayed at any other office or location where the Licensee conducts business in Westchester County.
