Re: Solid Waste Management
Activities Excluded under 329 IAC 10-3-1
WR Beach Exclusion Site
Indianapolis, Marion County

On December 11, 2017, in a telephone conversation with Mr. Timothy Hotz, a representative of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Office of Land Quality, you stated that the WR Beach Exclusion Sites, (Site #1, located at 821 West Sumner Avenue and Site #2, located at 4402 Bluff Road, Indianapolis, Indiana), are open to contractors who need to dispose of clean fill materials, namely uncontaminated soil, asphalt, concrete and bricks. On occasion, these contractors may need to document that the materials being disposed are going to a site that is approved by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management. The disposal of these solid waste materials is a solid waste management activity that is specifically excluded from regulation by 329 IAC 10-3-1, which states, "The following solid waste management activities are not subject to the provisions of this article: (1) Disposal of only uncontaminated rocks, bricks, concrete, road demolition waste materials, or dirt." Therefore, the activities that you are conducting at these sites do not require a permit from this office.
